BIARRITZ : GOLF DESTINATION

Heritage of the English aristocracy, Biarritz has one of **the oldest golf courses in Europe, the « Golf du Phare »**, created in 1888. What makes it special today is that it is located right in the town centre. Exactly 100 years later, **the Ibarritz-Bidart International Training Centre was opened, the only complex of this kind in Europe**, an expert facility in a superb setting overlooking the ocean. Biarritz is a meeting point for all European golf players as there **are exceptional courses and weather conditions** which allow outdoor activities **all year round**. The town's development strategy concerning golf led to the twinning with the American town of **Augusta, Georgia** (the world's golf capital) in 1991. Biarritz has entered into golfing legend, providing the impetus for many other famous courses in the area. Today, there are **ten other greens within a 15 miles radius of Biarritz**. Golf players can increase the level of their performance as they go from one golf course to another.

Biarritz le Phare, Par 69, 5402 m, Willie Dunn—Pure British tradition, it has managed to preserve the perfect integration within these special surroundings.

Makila Golf, Par 72, 6178 m, R. Roquemore Surrounded by beautiful oaks and arranged in vast spaces, it offers large fairways and all the holes are different from one another. **10 mn from Biarritz**

Arcanques Golf, Par 72, 6142 m, R. Fream 198 acres of oaks trees and meadows around the village and the chateau. **10 mn from Biarritz**

Golf de la Nivelle, Par 70, 5587 m, J.H. Taylor Offers beautiful views of the ocean, the port and bay of St Jean de Luz and a mountain panorama **20 mn from Biarritz**

Golf de Chantaco, Par 70, 5833 m, Harry Colt The course was designed in a valley and forest environment. This is an undulating parkland course difficult and diversified. **20 mn from Biarritz**

Hossegor Golf, Par 70, 5860m, J. Morisson It is sheltered from sea breezes. It was laid out in 1930, in virgin forest surroundings, and it succeeded in keeping // **its originality over the years. 30 mn from Biarritz**
